

Crown Game Breeders aims high to exceed sable records

The inspirational success story of Crown Game Breeders is founded on passion, well-researched knowledge and an extraordinary talent to identify animals with the

right conformation and potential.

Situated on the banks of the Matlabas River near Thabazimbi in the Limpopo Province, Crown Game Breeders recently opened a whole new dimension in sable breeding when two of their breeding bulls grew past 58".

Pieter Lamprecht and his partner, Ben Botha, focus on carefully selected cows and bulls that ensure genetic predictability towards achieving the dream of sables growing horns past 60".

"Our cows have proven themselves time and again to transfer strong genetic material and have even produced two sets of twins, which is proof of their high fertility," says Pieter. With contagious excitement he says that their top breeding bulls, Damascus and Rapella Junior, are both well on their way to meet and even exceed the 60" dream.





Pieter Lamprecht's passion for sables goes back to 2012 when he acquired Rapella, a Matetsi sable bull, as the genetic foundation for his sable breeding programme. Judging by the quality of his stud, Rapella proved to be a brilliant choice to strengthen and expand this proudly South African sable.


Pieter encourages game ranchers in South Africa to share their experiences and knowledge, and to mentor newcomers in the industry, since this ultimately contribute to the breeding and management of strong and robust animals that secure the future of the species.

Pieter's ambition to exceed current world records in horn lengths and his profound faith in the private wildlife ranching industry in South Africa add to the quality ingredients in Crown Game Breeders' recipe for success.

Pieter's scientific approach to stud farming leaves nothing to chance. He pays close attention to detail when researching the origin and performance of the animals he adds to his stud. During his early days as sable breeder, Pieter drove thousands of kilometres to visit other sable breeders, where he observed, learned and asked questions. This approach, together with his thorough methods, paid off when the industry acknowledged his diligence and named him the WRSA Wildlife Rancher of the Year in 2014.

fetch 1 500 USD from a foreign hunter, while a South African trophy hunter is quite prepared to pay R25 000 or the same animal. This shows us that local trophy hunters know the true value of animals and are willing to pay a premium," says Pieter.

There is currently a turn for the better in the stud animal market price. There was an anomaly in the prices obtained for stud animals and trophy hunting game. Trophy hunters were willing to pay prices that buyers of stud animals were not. However, it is starting to improve as breeders continuously add value to the species, and the stud animals fetch higher prices at 2022 auctions.

MARKET INSTABILITY POSES CHALLENGES

Pieter has a calming faith in South Africa's game ranching industry. "As a third-generation, fulltime farmer, I find myself in a privileged place in a challenging time. The instability in the market is one of the challenges that game farmers must deal with. I will however not lose sight of my goal and passion, which is to always add value to my herd while maintaining and improving the quality of the animals," he says.

Since 2020, the COVID-19 travel restrictions had a devastating impact on the foreign trophy hunting market, but business is picking up again. The local trophy hunting sector is looking good and should not be underestimated. "In South Africa, a trophy hunter can hunt a 50" sable bull or 48" buffalo bull, which you will rarely find anywhere else in the world. A select trophy black impala will

Crown Game Breeders is also the proud breeders of outstanding buffalo from two lines, i.e., **Horison** and **Matetsi**.

- The Horison line is known for wide-spread horns.
- The Matetsi line adds bulk and depth.
- Both lines have made good progress in boosting the quality of buffalo stud herds.

Horison in particular has strong prepotency by passing on excellent genes to both male and female offspring, which is not common for all buffalo bulls.

Both the Matetsi and Horison lines have already proven themselves and Pieter is particularly excited about the good results produced by combining the Horison and Matetsi lines in his breeding programme. Fertility is consistent with cows producing two calves in three years.

"Crown Game Breeders is committed to meet the constant demand for outstanding buffalo," Pieter says.

CONTRIBUTION TO CONSERVATION

Crown Game Breeders has a holistic approach to conservation and acknowledges the important contribution that hunters make towards game management and the industry at large. After selecting the top animals for stud purposes, the remaining animals are moved to a farm where they breed extensively.







ABIG KUDU BULL



Greater kudu (Tragelaphus strepsiceros).

he Waterberg Kudu Breeding Project is situated in the Waterberg region between Lephalale and Thabazimbi.

We breed exclusively with kudus. The project does not only select for the longest horns, but also focuses on the genetic diversity between the sire and dam.

The cows' genetics were periodically improved on the farm by removing all the weaker kudu bulls from the herds. This entire process has been done over the past 10 years, therefore ensuring only the best genetics are brought forward in new generations. Our current breeding bulls were meticulously selected from the finest kudu bull genes in South Africa. We were looking for a specific horn shape and big-bodied bulls – the whole

package! These genetics include genes from **Mr Wow** (77²/₈") and **Hercules** (68").

A scientific study showed the bull horn trophy size reduced by 40% over a period of 12 years on a 4 000ha farm, due to hunting pressure. This happened with an annual cull of 15-30% of the population size. These findings are true for most species. The Waterberg Kudu Breeding Project's aim is to reverse this human miscalculation by putting the big kudu horn genetics back into nature. Every farm deserves a big kudu bull.


